

Time Tempo Credits – Sign up & In Volunteer to join

<u>Tempo Time Credits</u> is a registered charity. Volunteers who sign up can gain credits to reward them for their volunteering hours.

Credits are awarded by your organisation's Volunteer administrator. They can be exchanged for a range of opportunities – see examples below

- Free entry to a heritage site: eg Caerphilly Castle; Raglan Castle; Blaenavon Ironworks, Plas Mawr, Conwy Castle
- Free entry to a play centre
- Adult Gym Days
- Anglesey Sea Zoo and similar parks
- Adult entry to centres such as Dangerpoint Talacre
- Online coaching or magazine subscriptions
- Theatre and cinema performances
- Sport events and free stadium tours

Process:

- 1. Manager signs up to Time Tempo Credits
- 2. Time Tempo Credits will contact the Manager and set up as admin
- 3. Manager logs in <u>Tempo Time Credits</u>
- 4. Manager sends an invite link to volunteer

Time Tempo Credits - Volunteer Reward Process

Process:

- 1. Volunteer fills in hours log form
- 2. Volunteer sends hours log form back to Manager by no later than last Monday of each month
- 3. Admin adds hours to volunteer account Tempo Time Credits
- 4. Admin assigns credits to volunteer (1 credit per hour)
- 5. Volunteer can accumulate credits for activities
